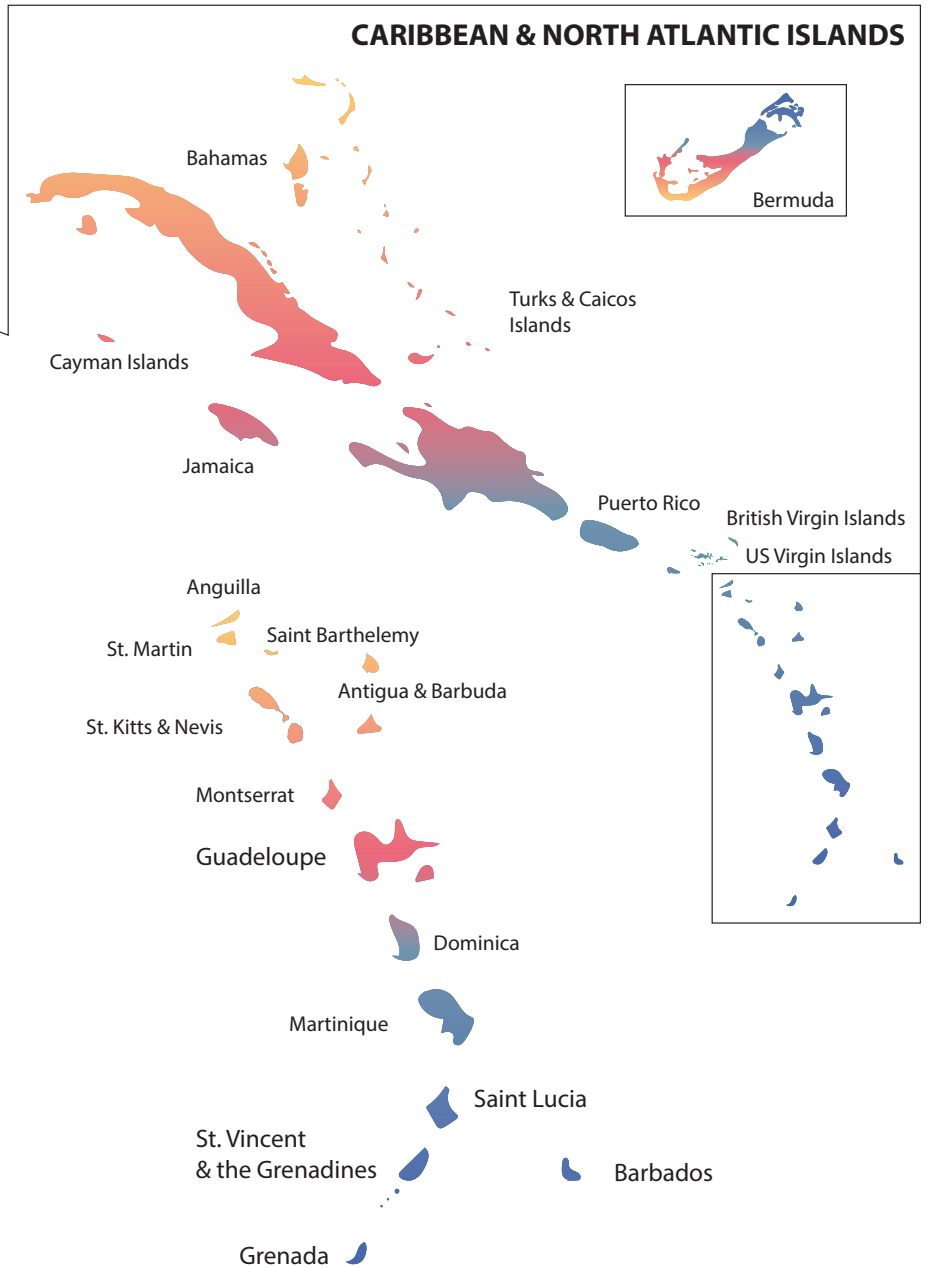

## PUBLIC POLICY GROUP

Hosted in conjunction with the Caribbean Telecommunications Union (CTU), this forum facilitates collaboration and information-sharing between governments, civil society, and academia actors to strengthen national and regional public policy in support of Internet development.



## JUSTICE SECTOR GROUP

This forum facilitates capacity-building, collaboration, and inter-agency cooperation specially targeted at judicial, law enforcement, and public safety officials in the ARIN region. Activities are conducted in collaboration with the global Regional Internet Registry community as well as other regional and global justice and cybersecurity agencies.



## TECHNICAL COMMUNITY GROUP

Hosted in collaboration with the Caribbean Network Operators Group (CaribNOG), this forum supports development of technical and network engineering skills through targeted outreach, capacity-building, resource-sharing, and the promotion of network engineering best practices.
