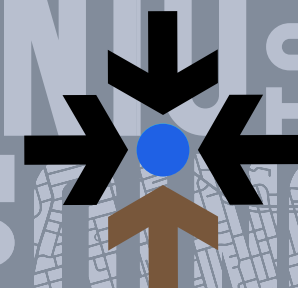

5. Listen to candidate speeches
6. CAST YOUR VOTE!

How to Cast Your Organization's Vote



Who Can Vote?

An organization must have been a **General Member in Good Standing** with a designated **Voting Contact** as of 9 September.

Organizations could update their Voting Contact after the Voting Eligibility deadline, but all changes had to be finalized at least seven days before the voting period begins, which was **Thursday, 17 October, at 3:00 PM ET.**

Accessing Your Ballot

After 3:00 PM ET/Noon PT today,
Eligible Voting Contacts should:


1. Log in to **ARIN Online**
2. Select the **“Vote Now”** link
3. Cast ballots for the **Board of Trustees, Advisory Council, and NRO NC**

Voting open 3:00 PM ET today through 7:00 PM ET on
1 November

Understanding Your Ballot

When viewing your ballot, you will see:

- Your name and vote weight
- The organizations you are casting a ballot on behalf of
- The email address that will receive the confirmation email

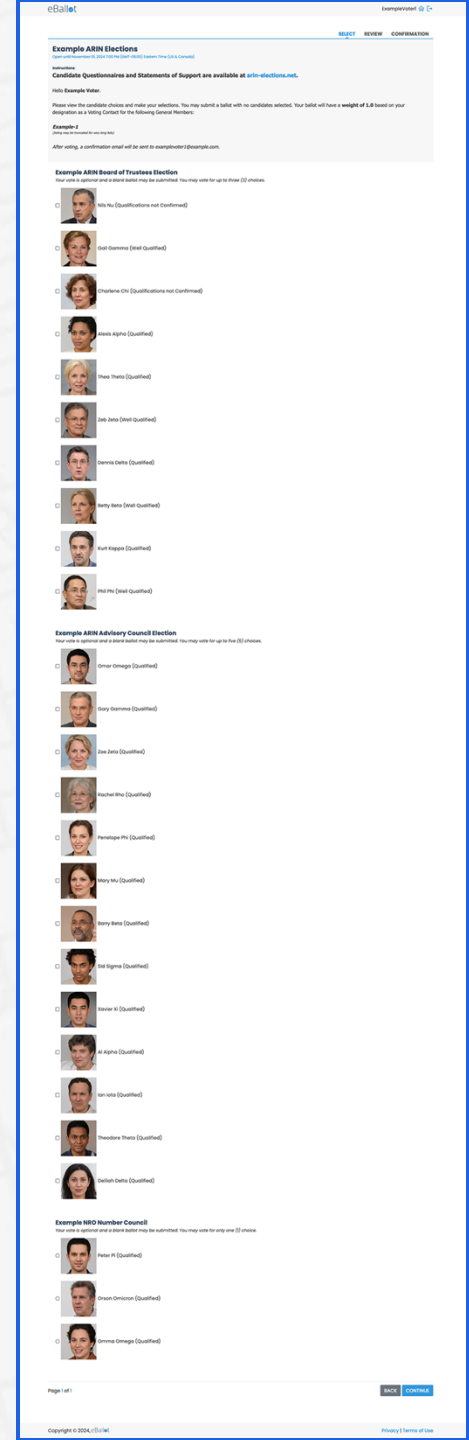


