The Advisory Council...

- Works with proposal authors to ensure that they have valid problem statements and are within the scope of ARIN's Policy Development Process (PDP)
- Develops Draft Policies by gathering input and presenting them as works in progress to the community
- Recommends Draft Policies that are:
 - Fair and impartial
 - Technically sound
 - Supported by community
- Initiates Last Call and reviews final comments
- Recommends to the Board of Trustees for adoption

Policy Work Since ARIN 40



- **Sent to the Board of Trustees for adoption:**
 - Recommended Draft Policy ARIN-2017-5: Improved IPv6 Registration Requirements (implemented in January)
- **Abandoned**
 - Draft Policy ARIN-2017-6: Improve Reciprocity Requirement for Inter-RIR Transfers
 - Did not gain sufficient community support to justify moving forward
 - Draft Policy ARIN-2017-4: Remove Bidirectional Requirement for Inter-RIR Transfers
 - Support and opposition split at ARIN 40 and on PPML
 - Consistent objection: “under current policies at other RIRs, 2017-4 would not have any effect on current address transfer practices.”

New Proposals Since ARIN 40

- ARIN-prop-244: Clarification of initial block size for IPv4 ISP transfers
 - Now Draft Policy 2017-9
- ARIN-prop-245: Repeal of Immediate Need for IPv4 Address Space (NRPM Section 4.2.1.6)
 - Now Draft Policy ARIN-2017-10
- ARIN-prop-246: Reallocation and Reassignment Language Cleanup
 - Became Draft Policy ARIN-2017-11
 - Now an editorial change pending AC review (no edits in community review period)

More New Proposals Since ARIN 40



- ARIN-prop-247: Require New POC Validation Upon Reassignment
 - Now Draft Policy ARIN-2017-12
- ARIN-prop-248: Remove ARIN Review Requirements for Large IPv4 Reassignments/Reallocations
 - Now Draft Policy ARIN-2017-13
- ARIN-prop-249: Verify Contacts on New Reassignments
 - Withdrawn (Incorporated into Draft Policy ARIN-2017-12)

EVEN MORE New Proposals Since ARIN 40



- ARIN-prop-250: Allow Inter-regional ASN Transfers
 - Now Draft Policy ARIN-2018-1
- ARIN-prop-251: Correct References to Rwhois
 - Now an editorial change under community review
- New this year:
 - ARIN-prop-252: Clarification to ISP Initial Allocation and Permit Renumbering
 - ARIN-prop-253: Remove Reallocation Requirements for Residential Market Assignments
 - ARIN-prop-254: Clarification on IPv6 Sub-Assignments
