## Staff and Legal Review (January 2018)



- Staff Understanding
  - Draft Policy 2017-13 removes the requirement for ARIN staff to review and approve customer reallocations/reassignments under NRPM 4.2.3.5.

### Staff and Legal Review (continued)



#### Staff Comments

- Removal of NRPM 4.2.3.5 will result in ARIN staff no longer reviewing and approving large reassignments/reallocations made from Direct Allocations.
- Note that ARIN staff will continue to follow our process of reviewing reassignments / reallocations to verify usage for IPv4 requests submitted for waitlist purposes or for recipient transfers.
- This policy could be implemented as written.

## Staff and Legal Review (continued)



- Legal Assessment
  - There are no material legal issues regarding this proposal

### Staff and Legal Review (continued)



- Resource Impact
  - Implementation of this policy would have minimal resource impact. It is estimated that implementation could occur within 3 months after ratification by the ARIN Board of Trustees.
  - The following would be needed in order to implement:
    - Updated guidelines and internal procedures
    - Staff training
    - Some engineering work will be required
