Staff Understanding

• This policy will eliminate the need for ISPs that have residential subscribers and have assigned address space to their access infrastructure to register these assignments with ARIN. Section 4.2.3.7.3.1 (Residential Market Area) will be removed in its entirety.





Staff Comments

Legal Assessment

 The policy does not appear to create any material legal issue





Resource Impact
