

Advisory Council Docket Report

- ARIN-2018-1: Allow Inter-regional ASN Transfers
 - Adds the ability for ARIN staff to transfer Autonomous System Numbers (ASNs) between RIRs that share reciprocal, compatible, needs-based policies. As with current Inter-RIR IP address space transfer policy, RIRs who do not allow bidirectional transfers are excluded.



- ARIN-2018-3: Remove Reallocation Requirements for Residential Market Assignments
 - Eliminates the requirement for ISPs that have individual IPv4 customers, otherwise referred to as residential subscribers to register reallocations and reassignments with ARIN for each of them.



- ARIN-2018-4: Clarification on Temporary Sub-Assignments
 - Adds clarifying language to the NRPM definitions of Assignments, Reassignments, Allocations, and Reallocations, to clarify that temporary or incidental use of address space by third parties do not qualify as reassignments or violate any other policies that restrict IP address space usage to the organization it is assigned or allocated to.



- ARIN-2017-12: Require New POC Validation Upon Reassignment
 - Adds an additional step to all requests for reallocations or detailed reassignments that will result in the creation of a new Point of Contact record (POC), which includes a ten-day window for the POC to validate the request information and avoid having the request rejected.

Draft Policy



- ARIN-2018-2: Clarification to ISP Initial Allocation and Permit Renumbering
 - Adjusts IPv4 initial allocation policy to allow organizations without direct allocations, direct assignments, re-allocations or reassignments to qualify for up to a /24 automatically, and larger if they document how they will utilize the space.

Editorial Changes



- ARIN-prop-256: Modify 8.3 and 8.4 for Clarity
 - Replaces the term "M&A" with the term "8.2" in 8.3 and 8.4 language to properly account for reorganizations
- ARIN-prop-255: NRPM Cleanup
 Addresses NRPM section header title-casing and collapsing of consecutive retired sections/subsections
